Bachelor of Physiotherapy (BPT)- (Batch-2026)

Information Handout

1 Introduction:

- 1.1** The Bachelor of Physiotherapy course is a full-time program of 5 years (4-year annual pattern and 1 year internship) leading to the degree that equips the student with analytical, evidence-based learning skills.
- 1.2** The program will be conducted in full compliance with the norms and standards prescribed by the National Commission for Allied and Healthcare Professions (NCAHP), Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India.

2 Eligibility Criteria:

- He/she must have passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) or equivalent examination by a recognized any Indian board or a duly constituted Board with pass marks with a minimum 50% in aggregate of physics, chemistry and biology (botany & zoology) & English is a mandatory subject.
- No candidate will be admitted on any ground unless he/she has appeared in the NEET examination of the same year
- Admission to Bachelor of Physiotherapy program shall be made on the basis of NEET examination. eligibility (minimum 50% with physics, chemistry and biology) and merit list based on 10+2 passing marks.
- Candidates who have studied abroad and have passed the equivalent qualification as determined by the Association of Indian Universities and Equivalence Committee of the NCAHP, and must fulfil the criteria as per points 1-3 above.
- He/she should have attained the age of 17 years as on - current year, as on the date of admission.
- He/she has to furnish at the time of submission of application form, a certificate of Physical fitness from an Authorized Medical Attendant to ascertain that the candidate does not have any physical disability as per the guideline mentioned below

- Those candidates who have passed, or, are appearing for 10+2 examination from a Board/University where Grade Point Average is given, such candidates must produce in writing from the Board / University concerned, the equivalent percentage for the GPA / CGPA obtained.
- Candidate whose final marksheet is not available at the time of admission is required to submit internet copy of the result duly attested by Principal of the school/college, failing which candidate will not be admitted.
- Duplicate registration will not be considered to be eligible for the program.
- Candidates above 25 years of age are not eligible to apply.
- Only single mark sheet with all compulsory subjects taken and passed will be considered, no compartmentalized mark sheet shall be considered.
- In case the mark sheet issued by the applicable Board / Institution is in percentile/s, the actual aggregate percentage of all the subjects appeared by the candidate will be taken into consideration.
- If at any stage, it is found that a candidate does not satisfy the eligibility criteria or the information furnished by him/her in the application form is incorrect, his/her admission to the course, even if selected/ admitted, will stand cancelled and fees will be refunded as per refund rule clauses.
- Candidate whose final mark sheet is not available at the time of admission are required to submit internet copy / Digi-Locker of result duly attested by Principal of the school / college with official seal, failing which, candidate will not be admitted.
- Candidate will not be eligible if any subject is marked as ungraded/fail in the marksheet / grade-sheet. For absent/ungraded in any of the additional/non-mandatory subjects will be consider as eligible, provided such a candidate is declared as pass by the respective board.
- Admission to the program is considered as **“Provisional Admission”** till all required and mandatory documents are submitted by the candidate and the same is verified and approved. If it is found that the candidate is not eligible at any stage (even after the course commencement), admission will be cancelled and fees will be refunded as per refund rule clauses even if selected / admitted to the program.
- The XII (Qualified) examination should have been conducted before the course commencement date.
- Mark sheet / Transcripts issued by Board / University only be considered (School / Institute will not be accepted).
- Candidates appearing for their final 10+2 or equivalent examination can also apply provided they obtain the required minimum cut off marks and also produce all the necessary documents, in original, within the given stipulated time.

- It is the sole responsibility of the candidate to ascertain whether they possess the necessary and requisite qualifications for admission to courses at NMIMS University.
- **For Foreign candidates, admission strictly follows NCAHP guidelines.**
- In the online registration or e-admission form (if selected) for the 10+2 or equivalent exam, candidates who have passed through any examining board (such as the State Board, CBSE, ICSE, etc.) should indicate the aggregate scores of all the subjects they have taken, opted for, and for which appeared for (not the best of four, five, six, or seven subjects).
- **For IB & Cambridge Candidate:** Candidates called for admission on the basis of merit list & who do not have final mark sheet will be given “Provisional Admission” based on predicted scores. Fees will be accepted from such candidate but their admission will be confirmed on submission of final mark sheet if found eligible before the commencement of the programme. Mark sheet / Transcripts issued by Board / University / Institute only be considered. For A Level Examination (Cambridge Board) with minimum 3 subjects at advance level will be taken into consideration for calculation of aggregate percentage. Ungraded subjects/grades will not be taken into account.
- **Diploma awarded** candidates from International Baccalaureate (IB) Board are considered to 10+2 or equivalence examination with 24 grades/credits compulsory and has passed 3 subjects at Higher Level (HL) and 3 subjects at Standard Level (SL) plus extended essay and TOK.
- **DP course** candidates from the International Baccalaureate (IB) Board are considered to 10 +2 or equivalent examination with 2 subjects at Higher Level (HL) and 2 subjects at Standard Level (SL) OR 3 subjects at Standard Level (SL) and 1 subject at Higher Level (HL)
- **BCP equivalence for General Strand** (Arts, Commerce, Science, Law): CP course candidates from the International Baccalaureate (IB) Board are considered 2 DP subjects with at least 1 subject at Higher Level (HL) and a minimum 3 points in each DP subject, along with Career-related studies with at least 03 subjects offered by IB.
- **IBCP equivalence for Engineering or Medicine Strand:** CP course candidates from International Baccalaureate (IB) Board are considered 3 DP subjects (Maths, Physics, Chemistry, Biology or other similar subjects) with at least 1 subjects at Higher Level (HL) and minimum 03 points in each DP subject along with Career related studies with at least 03 subjects offered by IB.
- Submission of AIU equivalence certificate to confirm the eligibility for the program is mandatory for those candidates who have completed their 10+2 or equivalent examination from overseas board/ Universities.
- IB Candidates have to enter ‘Predicted Scores’ in case final grades/ marks are not declared.

- Candidates who successfully pass the NEET 2026 examination can seek admission into BPT during the academic year 2026-2027.
- Candidate whose final mark sheet is not available at the time of admission is required to upload internet copy / Digi Locker copy of the result within 07 working days of the announcement of the final examination result to confirm the program eligibility. The candidate's admission will be revoked, if they fail to present the mandatory document within the specified timeline.
- **If at any stage of the program it is found that a candidate does not meet the eligibility criteria or has furnished incorrect information in the application form, his/her admission to the course, even if already admitted, will stand cancelled. Fees will be refunded as per the applicable refund rule clause. If the candidate does not voluntarily withdraw, the University will proceed with cancellation of admission.**
- **National Commission for Allied and Healthcare Professions (NCAHP), the NEET examination is responsible for screening and assessing candidates' eligibility for admission to the physiotherapy course.**

6 Candidate's application form will not be considered if they fail to upload the above-mentioned document till the last date of online registration.

7 Selection Process:

Merit list will be based on the NMIMS BPT CET, Personal interview, NEET examination score, and 12th Percentage.

- A. Entrance Test -50 Marks
- B. Personal Interview – 20 Marks
- C. NEET Score -20
- D. 12th Percentage-10

- Admission offer is given as per merit and vacancy. Selected Candidate has to confirm his / her provisional admission by filling up e-admission form, uploading required document and paying fees within given timeline. Kindly note that only those candidates who complete the process by paying fees will be admitted to the program.
- WAITLISTED candidates have to check their merit list status as per date given on the website.

6 Program Fees:

Fees for 1st year (Batch-2025) -Rs. 3,50,000/-

Fees for 1st year (Batch-2026) will be declared at the time of admission.

Refund Rules: As per the notification of UGC. Details will be shared at the time of admission.

Note: 1) Please note the closure of admission / last date of admission as mentioned in the important dates of the respective program.

2) The Candidate is requested to check the commencement date. The cancellation policy/date is applicable, as mentioned in the admission offer letter.

9 Important Instructions:

- Please see the important dates and preserve it as a guide. All announcements from the University will be through its website www.nmims.edu and there will be no separate mail sent. **Kindly check the website for regular updates.**
- It is the sole responsibility of the candidates to ascertain whether they possess the necessary and requisite qualifications for admission to the courses at NMIMS.
- AIU certificate is mandatory for those candidates who have completed their Graduation / Post-graduation from overseas Universities.
- Canvassing in any form will disqualify the candidate
- If at any stage, it is found that a candidate does not satisfy the eligibility criteria or the information furnished by him/her is incorrect, then the application for admission to the

Program, even if selected and fees paid, will stand cancelled and fees will be refunded as per the NMIMS refund policy.

- Admission for appearing Candidates will be provisional till submission of Final Marksheet and will be confirmed on submission & if found eligible as per eligibility criteria.
- Candidate's documents will be verified at the time of admission (if selected) & if found not eligible, admission will be cancelled and fees will be refunded as per NMIMS refund policy.
- **For cancellation/ withdrawal of admission:** Withdrawal / cancellation means voluntary withdrawal / cancellation by candidate for any reason. Candidate has to upload cancellation form duly filled and signed, fees paid receipt copy & cancelled cheque (personal account) to mentioned link : <https://upload.nmims.edu/admission/cancellation/>
- NMIMS has full right to disqualify a candidate at any stage of admission process if found ineligible. No separate intimation will be given in this regard.
